

## HOLLIES

**BLUE MAID:** A vigorous grower and perhaps the most hardy of all the Blue Hollies. Large bright red berries persist through winter and accent a broad pyramidal growth habit, it can reach 10' without pruning. Use Blue Maid for foundation plantings, hedges or screens, adaptable to different sunlight exposures.

**BLUE PRINCE:** Gorgeous bright blue green summer foliage takes on a bluish tone in the winter. It is a vigorous, broad upright, a good space filler that is easy to control. Excellent pollinator for nearly all female hollies. Will take sun to part shade, grows 6 – 8' tall and 3 – 5' wide.

**CHINA GIRL:** A very hardy, beautiful selection. Rich, dark, glossy green leaves cover the plant clear to the ground. Because of the dense branching habit, it takes shearing very well. A profusion of bright red berries that persist through winter is perhaps the best berry set found on any holly. Moderate grower, suitable as a foundation plant.

**CHINA BOY:** This vigorous grower makes an ideal hedge or low screen. Its dense branching habit takes shearing well. A great pollinator for nearby female hollies this plant displays deep green lustrous foliage. It is very cold tolerant and tolerates partial shade to full sun.

**DRAGON LADY:** Big, bright red berries contrast well against the background of this columnar holly. It is well branched and tight to the ground and covered with deep green jagged foliage. This columnar plant can provide a sense of structure in your garden, it does well as a specimen, or makes an excellent tall hedge or barrier. Plant in full to partial sun. The mature size is 16' tall and 5' wide.

**NELLIE R. STEVENS:** Relatively fast growing broad upright holly. The leaves are dark green and appear to have smoother edges than some of the other hollies. The berries are large and red, does best in full to partial sun. It is often classified as a broad pyramidal tree, as it can reach 25' in height.

**CENTENNIAL GIRL:** A naturally pyramidal, mite resistant holly with deep green, matte foliage. The berry set on this relatively new variety is truly amazing well into early spring. A lovely addition as a small evergreen in your yard or as a corner piece in your foundation planting. The mature size is 15' x 6'.

**HELLERI:** A neat dwarf specimen that fits nicely among dwarf conifers. Its dense habit makes it a good choice as an edging plant. The lustrous dark green leaves are abundant on this mounding plant. More particular to soil conditions than originally thought, plant in moist, well drained soil and water thoroughly as plant is getting established. Mature size is 4' x 4'.

**COMPACTA:** This dwarf plant makes an excellent hedge or border plant. The dense twiggly habit shears nicely and can easily be kept at 2' tall. Plant in full to part sun. Use as a foundation plant or low hedge.

**SOFT TOUCH:** A very dense, compact, evergreen that grows wider than tall. It has flat, lustrous dark green leaves that holds a nice color all winter. Use as a sidewalk border or in a foundation planting. A new variety that will be used frequently in the future.
